Arbeitskreis Vignetten- und Anekdotenforschung

Criteria for nomination/presentation

–Socio-critical claim

Contribution of the work to social, educational, democratic and emancipatory issues

–VignA-inspired research approach

The methodology used must be based on *phenomenological vignettes and anecdotes* or the *related methods used in the network*, such as *Erinnerungsbilder, Wahrnehmungsvignetten (perceptual vignettes)* or *other phenomenological descriptions*.

Basis of the analysis

- Preference will be given to work that is theoretical AND/OR empirical in nature
- Independence (independent thought processes/methodological approaches, critical examination of the topic)
- Innovative questions/innovative theoretical and methodological approaches

VignA-Award - procedure

Stage 1:

Recommendation by a counsellor (once a year)

Stage 2:

Selection is made by the VignA core team

Stage 3:

Presentation of the awards once a year at a VignA conference
