Criteria for nomination/presentation

-Socio-critical claim

Contribution of the work to social, educational, democratic and emancipatory issues

-VignA-inspired research approach

The methodology used must be based on phenomenological vignettes and anecdotes or the related methods used in the network, such as Erinnerungsbilder, Wahrnehmungsvignetten (perceptual vignettes) or other phenomenological descriptions.

Basis of the analysis

- Preference will be given to work that is theoretical AND/OR empirical in nature
- Independence (independent thought processes/methodological approaches, critical examination of the topic)
- Innovative questions/innovative theoretical and methodological approaches

VignA-Award - procedure

Stage 1:

Recommendation by a counsellor (once a year)

Stage 2:

Selection is made by the VignA core team

Stage 3:

Presentation of the awards once a year at a VignA conference
